Her junior career earned her a scholarship to Furman University where she made an immediate impact on her team. Stefanie was team captain 4 consecutive years, won the Southern Conference twice, and held the lowest stroke average for a season at Furman; a lofty accomplishment following such alumnae as Dottie Pepper and Betsy King. While in her junior year at Furman, Stefanie qualified for the US Open, missing the cut by one stroke. She shot a 71 the second day, scoring better than all but five in the field. The experience fueled her desire to take her golf to the next level.

Qualifying for the Symetra Tour was a great experience. New friends, challenges and opportunities were in her future. Being selected for the Big Break Mexico and Big Break NFL have created a new fan base, great experiences and national exposure for Stefanie.
